



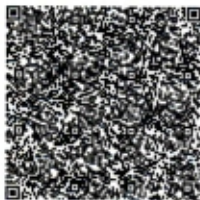

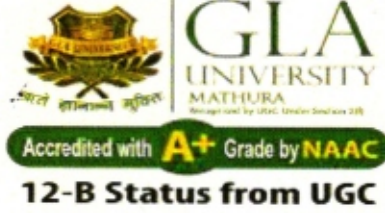

The MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is made between **Centre of Excellence for Indian Knowledge Systems, GLA University**, Mathura established under U.P. State Legislative Act of 2009 (UP Act 21 of 2010) and ranked among the top Universities of Uttar Pradesh and India and has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with 'A+' Grade and recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 2F of UGC Act of 1956, and is granted 12B status. GLA University, Mathura U.P. (hereinafter referred to as & "GLAU") on the OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MOU) are hereinafter individually referred to as PARTIES.

And

Centre for Indic Studies, a research department to promote studies and research on various aspects of Indian Civilization, located at Ahmedabad, Gujarat 382115 under **Indus University**, a private university established in 2006, providing Engineering, Management, Architecture, Design, Science, Aviation Degree programs in undergraduate, postgraduate & PhD (which expression shall include its successor and permitted assignees) of the other part.

PURPOSE


1. The purpose of this memorandum of understanding (MOU) is to establish a general framework of co-operation, roles and responsibilities between the **Centre of Excellence for Indian Knowledge Systems, GLA University** and **Centre for Indic Studies, Indus University**. GLA University, Mathura is setting up of **Braj Culture and Braj Bhasha Peeth** (ब्रजसंस्कृति एवं ब्रजभाषापीठ) (hereinafter referred to as "Peeth") under the Centre of Excellence for Indian Knowledge Systems in which **Centre for Indic Studies, Indus University**, will be expected to provide the expertise and access to all resources on IKS in print and digital (here includes library books, journals, manuscripts, artifacts, archives, museum, etc.) for the research projects undertaken by the **Peeth**.
2. It also includes the exchange of ideas on research publications, academic programs, seminars, workshops and research projects and promotion of Braj Bhasha and Braj Culture and incubation.
3. Promotion of collaborative research in areas of mutual interest.
4. Development of short-term academic and training programs in Education and Research of agreed subject areas of Indian Knowledge Systems especially in Braj language, literature, culture, and allied subjects.

Scope, Goals and Forms of Co-operation

1. Exchange of ideas with the objective of offering courses and realizing research projects in areas mutually agreed upon by both parties through prior invitation and in accordance with the procedures established by each institute and specific department.

- II. Exchange of academic and research resources that includes publications, study programs, projects, course information, seminars, conferences and any other data and information as mutually agreed of common interest.
- III. Both the institutions will develop joint research projects; promote incubation technology, organization of seminars, symposia, workshops and imparting training programs in the field of information, conservation, preservation and documentation of tangible and intangible cultural heritage for the benefit of both organizations.

Management

- I. Person-in-Charge, Centre of Excellence for Indian Knowledge system, GLAU and Director, Centre for Indic Studies, Indus University, will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between both the organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of the MOU.
- II. Both the Parties or their representatives will meet at least twice in a year or more than twice alternatively in the institution to review the activities. This meeting shall include presentation on the academic and research activities, which should be open to all technical staff.

Financial Management


- I. The financial expenditure for any joint event, joint program, joint research activities, or similar activities undertaken under this MoU except the cost of the establishment of offices and other purpose which will be borne by the GLAU, other expenditure will be borne by one or both institutions on mutual consent on case-to-case basis.

Implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

- I. It is understood that the both parties subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of state, race, sex, age, cast or religion. Both the institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of officers, scholars, and students, which violate principles of non-discrimination.
- II. The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information.

Protection of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)/Copyright/Ownership

- I. Copyright on the publications of book(s), research outcome (s), reprint (s) etc. will be with one or both parties on mutual consent on case-to-case basis.
- II. However, all rights related to commercial aspects of IPR, and patent including marketing, loss and profit will remain with GLAU.



Confidentiality

- I. Confidential information includes all communication of information disclosed in documentary or tangible form between the Parties, including oral, written and machine-readable form, pertaining to the above which is indicated as confidential.
- II. No information or part of information will be disclosed orally, written or visually about the research, publication, patent or any product or output under the MoU.

Terms and Conditions

- I. This MoU shall become effective from the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid till the date both parties mutually dissolve it. This MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given to the other party at least three months in advance from the effective date of termination.
- II. No amendment or modification of the MOU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or other authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be amendment of the MOU. The modification/ changes shall become part of the MOU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed unless otherwise agreed.
- III. Logo of both parties will be displayed in each event in joint collaboration.

Arbitration

- I. Any issues that are not addressed or stipulated in the MoU shall be discussed and resolved through negotiation in good faith and such resolution will be incorporated as written amendments to the MoU by mutual agreement between two Parties.
- II. No disputes are foreseen in the implementation of the MoU. The two Parties, however, agree that if any dispute arises between them, efforts will be made to settle the same as amicably as possible. If the dispute remains unsettled, it will be referred for resolution bilaterally to Registrar GLA University, Mathura and Director of Centre for Indic Studies, Indus University, Ahmedabad. The decisions so arrived at shall be final and binding on the both parties to this MoU.

Single Point of Contact (SPOC)

Each party shall designate a person or office to serve as liaison for implementing this MoU. The liaison/SPOC may change from time to time upon notice given to the other party in writing pursuant to this MoU.






